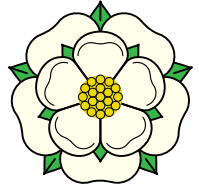

Gracious Shepherd, strengthen clergy and all who care for others. Renew them with your peace and perseverance. Amen.

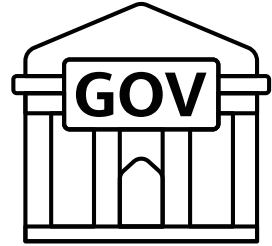

God of grace, we thank you for Mary's example of faith. Help us to say "yes" to your calling in our lives. Amen.

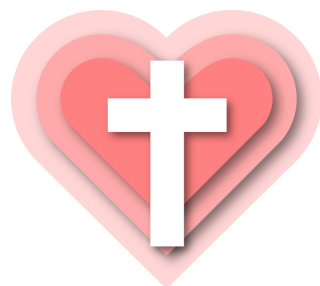
Lectionary Reading: Song of Solomon 2: 1-7

God our protector, watch over emergency services. Give them strength, courage, and safety in their work. Amen.

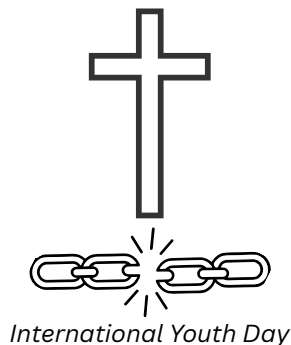
Lectionary Reading: Micah 1: 1-9

Creator God, teach us to care for your earth. Guide us in wise stewardship and renewal of creation. Amen.

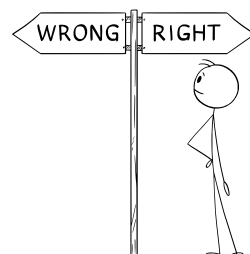
Lectionary Reading: Mark 6: 1-13
