<sup>††</sup> If you aren't sure which Church of England parish you live in, please enter your postcode into the search box on **www.achurchnearyou.com** and look for the church flagged "This is the parish church". If either or both of you live in a different parish from the church you're getting married at, you'll need to arrange for the banns to be read there, too.

A least seven days' notice is required before the first reading of banns.

Your vicar will let you know when your banns will need to be read. You might want to come to church to hear them read and you'd be very welcome.
